Geohellas S.A. is a Greek technical clays company established for the purpose of exploiting one of the largest attapulgite and saponite deposits in Europe. Following an extensive geological research, Geohellas today has mapped and is in possession of the mining rights for these deposits. The ongoing drilling and mapping program has already confirmed reserves in excess of 20,000,000 MT.

Geohellas's modern processing plant is located adjacent to the mines near the city of Grevena in Northern Greece, to facilitate integrated production (mining, processing, packaging). Selective mining is performed in four different mines. Processing capabilities include natural drying, pre-crushing, extrusion, crushing, drying/thermal activation, screening/sizing, milling, micronizing and classification. Packaging capabilities are versatile and range from big bulk bags to small open mouth type bags and carton boxes.

The plant has an annual production capacity of 160,000 MT and provisions for expansions have already been made. Production and sales commenced in late 2004 giving emphasis on technical products. Most of the products are exported to Europe, Asia and South America.

Products include, agricultural carriers, animal feed supplements, bleaching earths, cat litters, additives in construction products, technical products for environmental applications, free flow and anti-caking additives, gelling/suspension aids, industrial absorbents, binders in molecular sieves, soil improvers and others.
